MOPS Australia Awards

As groups reach out to mums in their communities some individuals and organisations make outstanding contributions and demonstrate exceptional commitment to the ministry in a variety of ways. The Board of MOPS Australia has adopted an award structure in order to publicly recognise and honour those contributions.

1. *Heart of MOPS Award*: presented annually to a person who has demonstrated unusual commitment to the mission of MOPS Australia:
2. *Spirit of MOPS Award*: recognises a Chartering ministry, church, MOPS Group or supportive business/organisation that is implementing the vision of MOPS in the local community or further afield;
3. *Hands of MOPS Award*: honours individual MOPS leaders who have made significant contributions to MOPS at a local and/or regional area over an extended period; and
4. *MOPPETS Carer 10 Year Service Award*: recognises MOPPETS Carers who have served their group in the area of MOPPETS for 10 years or longer.

Awards are presented to recipients at a MOPS Conference or other appropriate MOPS function.

Award Criteria

Spirit of MOPS Award Criteria

The *Spirit of MOPS* Award will be given to a Chartering Ministry, Church or MOPS Group or supportive business/organisation who:

- Have reached beyond their walls to carry out the vision of MOPS in a significant way in their community; and/or
- Have made a significant contribution to the work of MOPS;
- Have demonstrated ministry goals in keeping with both the MOPS Purpose Statement and the Faith Position Statement; and
- Have no known moral or legal reasons that would preclude them from nomination or bring MOPS Australia into disrepute.

Nominations for Spirit of MOPS are due by 30 April.
