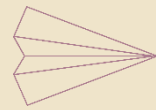
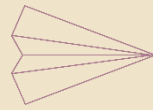
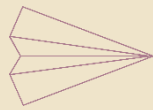
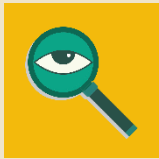


FUN THINGS TO DO AT HOME



1. I Spy

Variations of "I Spy" for younger children:



- Use colours as clues.
- Children close their eyes. You choose an object to hold and say:

God made you and God made me.
When you open your eyes, what do you see?

2. Spot the bug

If your child has a watering can, help them water plants in your garden. If your child likes to splash water around, make that another game. While you're outdoors, see if you can spot any birds, butterflies, beetles or other creatures.



3. Finger rhymes

Use fingers as actions for the Two Little Dickie Birds rhyme.



Two little Dickie Birds, sitting on a wall,
One named Peter, the other named Paul.
Fly away Peter, fly away Paul,
Come back Peter, come back Paul.

Do it lots of times. Change the names for fun.

4. Cloud-gazing

Lie on the ground together and look at the clouds. Are they moving? Where are they going? Which way is the wind blowing? Find pictures in the clouds. Tell each other stories about what you see in the clouds.



5. Reading

Sit together and read a 'lift the flap' book or other favourite story book.



6. Picnic

Spread out a picnic blanket in the back yard and have a morning tea picnic.
